

Port Of Kingston

Vessel Registration Requirements

Per the Washington State House of Representatives House Bill 2457, Vessels mooring at the Port of Kingston must adhere to Chapter 88.02.420 RCW – Vessel Registration

Required Information:

The name of the legal owner of the vessel;

A local contact person and that person's address and telephone number, if different than the owner;

The owner's address and telephone number;

The vessel's hull identification number;

If applicable, the vessel's Coast Guard registration;

The vessel's home port;

The date on which the moorage began;

The vessel's country or state of registration and registration number; and

Proof of vessel registration, or a written statement of the lessee's intent to register a vessel, or an affidavit in a form and manner approved by the department of revenue certifying that the vessel is exempt from state vessel registration requirements as provided by RCW [88.02.570](#).

For moorage agreements entered into effective on or after July 1, 2014, a long-term moorage agreement for vessels not registered in this state must include, in a form and manner approved by the department and the department of revenue, notice of state vessel registration requirements as provided by this chapter and tax requirements as provided by chapters [82.08](#), [82.12](#), and [82.49](#) RCW and listing requirements as provided by RCW [84.40.065](#).

The above requirements are mandatory to moor and/or continue to moor at the Port of Kingston. Failure to provide and keep in force valid vessel registration can result in termination of moorage agreement and eviction from the marina.
