

PORT OF KINGSTON

RESOLUTION 06-02-2014

WHEREAS, the Port of Kingston is a special purpose Port district established under the laws of the State of Washington, and


WHEREAS, RCW 42.56.070 permits a local agency to not maintain an index of records if to do so would be unduly burdensome; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, Port of Kingston, finds that maintaining an index would unduly burdensome and would interfere with agency operations by detracting from the Port fulfilling its mission due to fiscal and personnel limitations because the Port of Kingston has less than 10 full time staff members. It is practically not feasible to maintain a central index of documents within the port's organizational structure. Even if such an index was feasible, the cost in terms of manpower, inefficiency, and delayed ability to respond to substantive issues would be prohibitive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Port of Kingston that the Port of Kingston will not be required to maintain an index of records. The Commission's determination made in this section shall be considered to be a "formal order" as that term is used by RCW 42.56.070.
