A Resolution of the Commission of the Port of Kingston

RESOLUTION TO APPOINT PORT DAMAGE CLAIM AGENT

WHEREAS, the Port of Kingston is a special purpose district established under the laws of the State of Washington; and

WHEREAS, RCW 4.96.020 requires that “the governing body of each local government entity shall appoint an agent to receive any claim for damages made under this chapter”; and

WHEREAS, the Commission of the Port of Kingston, by Resolution 04-03-2016, designated former Executive Director Jim Pivarnik to accept claims for damages filed under the Revised Code of Washington (RCW); and

WHEREAS, Jim Pivarnik’s position of employment ended on September 17, 2018; and

WHEREAS, Greg Englin’s first day of employment as Executive Director began on November 26, 2018; and


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commission of the Port of Kingston that Executive Director Greg Englin is hereby designated as the Port of Kingston’s Damage Claim Agent and as such is authorized to receive, on behalf of the Port of Kingston, any claim for damages made under the RCW.

The Executive Director may be reached during normal business hours of the Port of Kingston at 25864 Washington Blvd. NE, Kingston Washington 98346.


This designation shall be recorded with the Kitsap County Auditor’s Office in accordance with RCW 4.96.020.


