**RESOLUTION TO APPOINT GREG ENGLIN, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AS ACTING PROJECT MANAGER
FOR THE SR104 FERRY LOT FEASIBILITY STUDY.**

WHEREAS, The Port of Kingston has a direct interest to improve the safety and operation of all transportation along the SR104; through and around the Kingston community, and throughout the Port district. The Port of Kingston strongly supports this project as one component with an overall effort to manage traffic flows throughout the Kingston community and on behalf of our Port District residents, local business owners, community groups, and visitors to our community. The Port of Kingston also supports this initiative as part of a mutually beneficial effort to provide transportation solutions with our partners, Washington State Department of Transportation, Washington State Ferries, Kitsap County, and Kitsap Transit. The Port of Kingston will support the SR 104 Lindvog Ferry Holding Lot project by serving as the lead agency coordinating the effort funded by the Special Transportation Planning Study Agreement GCB 3080. As lead agency, The Port of Kingston will be the project manager and administrator of the designated funding.

WHEREAS, The Port of Kingston rescinds the appointment of Commissioner Mary McClure as Acting Project Manager for the SR 104 Ferry Lot Feasibility Study and appoints Executive Director, Greg Englin will act as Project Manager.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Commissioners for the Port of Kingston that Executive Director, Greg Englin is hereby designated as the Acting Project Manager for the duration SR104 Ferry Lot Feasibility Study. Such appointment shall be effective as of October 23, 2019.
