6. FINANCIAL REPORT

Larry Hurley from Hearthstone CPA provided an Accounts Compilation Report of Financial Statements for the 2019 yearend financial review. Report highlights include transitioning from cash to accrual, and the addition of accounts receivable, inventory & prepaid insurance. The capital assets are now included on the balance sheet. Other report additions include accounts payable, accrued expenses and long-term liability. Mr. Hurley stated the Port is in a good financial equity position at just under \$8,000,000.00 dollars as of 12/31/19. At the end of 2018, the Port ended with \$831,000.00 total cash and investments and at the end of 2019 ended with \$1,738,000.00. He predicts a \$500,000.00 increase at the end of 2020. Mr. Hurley stated that the Port has done a good job increasing cash reserves and is headed in the right direction of being fiscally responsible.

Executive Director Englin discussed the life cycle analysis of assets within the Port Capital Program. He discussed the repair, replacement and depreciation of fixed assets and his future plans to set up financial policies & asset report.

Commissioner McClure inquired on specific items on page five of the report including office supplies, credit card fees & operating supplies. Mr. Hurley and Port staff explained that these expenses include new computers, a new server network, a lawn mower, Christmas lights, and the regular marina operating supplies purchased in 2019. Mr. Hurley added there was also an increase in salaries, payouts and new employees hired in 2019. Controller McDonald explained the credit card fees are fees implemented by the three different credit card companies for the processing of credit card payments. Commissioner McClure stated when these types of things represent changes in operations that affect the public, she needs to understand them.

Commissioner McClure also inquired on user charges from page seven including deposits forfeited and asked what has changed operationally. Controller McDonald explained that these are the reservation fees collected from Dock WA and the deposit forfeited is when customers who have paid a deposit but did not show up therefore, we keep the deposit.

Controller McDonald stated that the reporting format will be changing next month a budgeted line for each month to show actual and total, it will also show month by month to show trends. Executive Director Englin added it will be a simpler report layout showing the trend line, variance and base line.

7. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Mr. Karzmar stated his appreciation on work done on Port financials. Mr. Karzmar expressed the importance of developing a vision for Kingston. He encouraged the Port staff and Commission to take an aggressive approach to develop a vision. He recommended recruiting members and forming an advisory group to further add clarity. He added there are a large number of young people moving to the Kingston area and recommended recruiting form local Homeowners Associations. He encouraged the Port pursue a bond or levy effort.



The commission discussed a strategic planning effort to engage the public including creating a community newsletter, committee and meetings, utilizing the new chamber website and reaching out to local homeowner associations.

8. COMMISSIONER REPORTS

Commissioner Gronnvoll reported she attended the Kitsap Economic Development Alliance breakfast. She shared that Washington is one of the top 10 states for job growth and there are 740,000 projected job openings in the next 5 years. Kitsap County residents spend 90% of their income in Kitsap County and over half of Kitsap County residents commute less than 10 miles. There are 250 miles of coastline around Kitsap County and the second most spoken language is Japanese. Predictions also include a 2% increase in population growth, increased commuting & retail and higher home value.

Commissioner McClure reported the community conversation planning group met recently and they are preparing for the third community conversation on April 4th from 8am to 2pm. The sponsors include the Port, Kingston, The Kingston Chamber of Commerce the Citizen Advisory council, Kingston Cares and the Village Green Foundation. Each sponsor will contribute a small amount of time and money.

Commissioner Heacock reported he attended the first meeting of the Kitsap Regional Coordinating Council (KRCC) on February 4th. He added, the members were very welcoming, and he discussed the benefit to everyone that the Port is an active member of that group. Commissioner Heacock also reported that he attended the Fourth of July committee meeting on behalf of the Port. where the event calendar and event outreach were discussed.

Commissioner McClure was pleased with the Ports participation in the KRCC. She noted the importance of the Port's involvement in these conversations to collaborate on regional transportation. She provided information on the various KRCC committees and designated representatives.

9. STAFF REPORTS

Controller McDonald reported she is currently working on the Port's annual report due May 29, 2020. She is also renumbering the Port's chart of accounts to line up with the BARS manual.

Executive Assistant Dofelmier reported on the status of staff cross training, Controller recruitment and Concerts on the Cove sponsorship agreements & Entertainment Contracts.

Executive Director Englin reported on the following items:

1. The first "Lunch with Greg" event was a success. He plans to hold these monthly and will create important topics for each event.



- 2. The Port will be publishing an updated marina rate study which gives customers empirical bases and will lead into recommendations for next year. Faith Reese headed up that effort with Harbormaster Carpenter's guidance
- 3. The Kingston Cove Sailing Regatta will take place this Saturday Feb 29th. The event will include 4 high school sailing clubs.
- 4. The Hidden Gems event is March 7th. This event honors Kingston Community Volunteers and the Port will be sponsoring two tables.
- 5. The Washington Recreation and Conversation Office (RCO) self-certification is due March 1. Executive Director Englin is working closely with Marc Horton (contracted Port Engineer) and Kim Sellers (RCO) to determine grant funding options from the Port's Capital Plan. May 1st is the submittal deadline.
- 6. The SR104 ferry holding Lot feasibility Study is moving forward with Perteet including analysis.
- 7. The Kitsap Public Utility District is KPUD is replacing the water line at the marina, which is critical infrastructure for Kingston.

Executive Director Englin expressed thanks to Controller McDonald for recruiting our Concerts on the Cove Gold Sponsor, Paula Weissinger. He thanked her for her help transitioning the Port from cash to accrual & from BARS to GAAP and her assistance with guiding the Port though the state audit.
